**Palo Duro Canyon:** a glimpse of the landscape that animated Georgia O'Keeffe

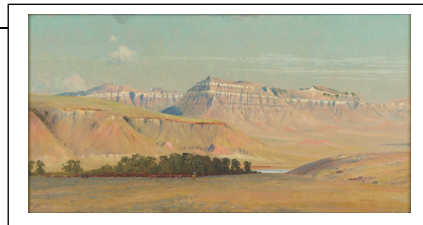
Lunch in Plainview or Lubbock
